OUR GOALS:

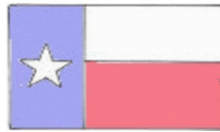
The SRT shall organize and promote public recognition of dates and places of historical significance to the Republic of Texas with monuments and other appropriate signage or event.

WHAT ELSE DOES YOUR CHAPTER DO?

A. The Lone Star Chapter issues the “**True Texian**” award and certificate for any one who serves the needs of the state of Texas. This is an 8 ½ by 14 certificate that proclaims the recipient a “True Texian”. This award is for companies or individuals that work to preserve, promote, or protect Texas History. This honor is open to members and non-members alike.

B. We Sponsor three annual “**Outstanding Texas History Educator of the Year**” awards within the Conroe Independent School District. The award recognizes the outstanding achievement of educators who teach Texas History at the 4th or 7th grade levels. This award comes with certificates and a \$1,000 total cash award. Additionally, the Lone Star chapter will also present the school where the teacher works with a Texas history play put on by Bob Heinonen – Bob does a great job and his website is located here: (www.TexasHeroes.net).

C. We host the “**Order of the Lone Star**”. This is a **very** honored, prestigious award that may only be granted via majority vote in a business meeting for the Lone Star Chapter. The award includes a certificate, induction letter, and a high quality, hand jeweled medallion with a ribbon and a custom wood box. This award can go to any member that has gone “above and beyond” for the cause of Texas. A maximum of two can be granted every year.
